
Public notice indicating that an enrolment scheme has been implemented.



To avoid overcrowding, or the likelihood of overcrowding, the Board of

Trustees of Oceanview Heights School has implemented an enrolment scheme that has been developed by the Secretary for Education.

Under this scheme, students will be enrolled if they live within the home zone described below.

The enrolment of out-of-zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education and Training Act 2020.

The enrolment scheme, which includes a precise description of the home zone, may be viewed at the school office, where copies of the scheme are also available.

OCEANVIEW HEIGHTS SCHOOL - Enrolment Scheme - Commences 9th October 2023

Home Zone:

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Starting from the intersection of Seaton Road and Kellands Hill Road

- South along Kellands Hill Road to Pages Road Including all addresses on Seaton Road
- East on Pages Road to Usk Street Including addresses on Pages Road between Kellands Hill Road and Mountain

View Road up to and including 233 Pages Road on the north side

- South on Usk Street to Kent Street Including addresses on Lindsay Street between Usk Street and Balmoral Street, up to and including 41 Lindsay Street on the north side
- South-east on Kent Street to Glen Street
- South-east on Glen Street to Selwyn Street
- South on Selwyn Street to Hobbs Street Including 156 Selwyn Street
- North-east on the north side only of Hobbs Street to Evans Street
- North-east on Evans Street to Newman Street Including addresses from 93 Evans Street to 111 Evans
 Street inclusive
- North-west on Newman Street to Marchwiel Street
- West on Marchwiel Street to Cross Street
- North on Cross Street to Andrew Street Including addresses on Luxmoore Road between Cross Street and Argyle Street, including address 71 Luxmoore Road on the north side - Including addresses to the east on Andrew Street to 19 Andrew Street on the north side and 24 Andrew Street on the south side inclusive
- West on Andrew Street to Dunkirk Street Including MacDonald Street to 83 MacDonald Street on the northside and 86 MacDonald Street on the south side inclusive
- Continue west on the south side only of Andrew Street to Old North Road Including the north side only of Old North Road up to 20 Old North Road

 North-west across the country to the intersection of Seaton Road and Kellands Hill Road - Including addresses on Washdyke Flat Road between Kellands Hill Road and Hilton Highway (SH1) - Including addresses on Spur Road between Kellands Hill Road and King Road, up to number 482 Spur Road inclusive and including addresses on Rosewill Valley Road between Washdyke Flat Road and Cartwright Road.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of Zone Enrolments:

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- 1. First priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- 2. Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- 3. Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- 4. Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is the child of a former student of the school.
- 5. Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board.
- 6. Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
